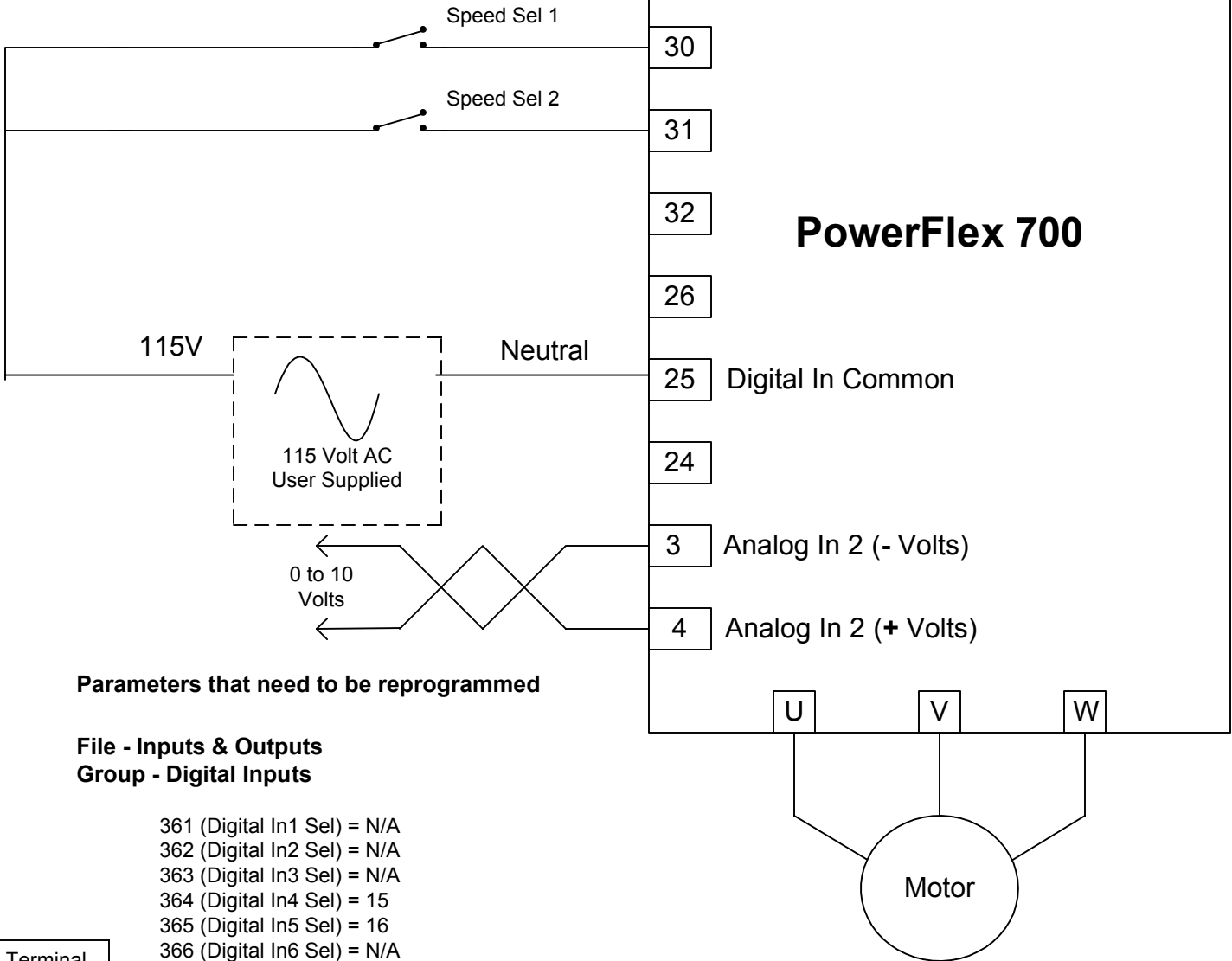


Selecting 3 Different Speed Command Sources 0 to Volts, Preset 1 = 10 Hertz, Preset 2 = 30 Hertz

Speed Sel 1 = Open
Speed Sel 2 = Open = Speed Source is 0 to 10 Volts

Speed Sel 1 = Closed
Speed Sel 2 = Open = Speed Source is Preset 1

Speed Sel 1 = Open
Speed Sel 2 = Closed = Speed Source is Preset 2

Parameters that need to be reprogrammed

File - Speed Command Group - Speed References

- 90 (Speed Ref A Sel) = 2 (Analog In 2)
- 93 (Speed Ref B Sel) = 11 (Preset Spd 1)

File - Speed Command Group - Discrete Speeds

- 101 (Preset Speed 1) = 10 Hz
- 102 (Preset Speed 2) = 30 Hz
